

# **WEEKLY DENGUE UPDATE**

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#### **DENGUE CASE REPORTING**

During  $6^{th}$  week, 1787 suspected dengue cases were reported in 26 districts in comparison to 1993, in 26 districts during the  $5^{th}$  week. There is 10.3% decrease in  $6^{th}$  week, compared to the previous week. Of all reported cases, 33.5% were from Western Province [Colombo Municipal Council – 5.0%, rest of the Colombo District – 14.3%, Gampaha District – 9.6% and Kalutara District – 4.6%]. Jaffna [15.7%], Kandy [5.5%], Galle [5.4%], Kurunegala [5.3%], Batticaloa [4.5%] and Kegalle [4.3%] districts also have reported higher number of cases (Table 1).

#### **HIGH RISK MOH AREAS (Table 2)**

During  $6^{th}$  week, 29 MOH areas were flagged as high-risk. Of them, 11 MOH areas showed rising numbers than their respective numbers in previous week. Persistently high number of patients are observed in 24 MOH areas in both  $5^{th}$  and  $6^{th}$  weeks.

The MOH areas that were newly flagged as high-risk areas in 6<sup>th</sup> week are Gampola, Eravur, Galenbindunuwewa, Egoda Uyana and Negombo. The MOH areas that were flagged as high-risk in 5<sup>th</sup> week and not flagged for the current week are; Kandy MC, Yatinuwara, Nallur, Bope Poddala, Battaramulla, Dehiwala, Piliyandala, Pitakotte, Ja-Ela and Wadduwa.

#### MIDNIGHT TOTAL OF DENGUE PATIENT ADMISSIONS

\* After updated with delayed reporting from hospitals, average midnight total for the 5<sup>th</sup> week shows a decrease from 601 to 593.

In 6<sup>th</sup> week average midnight total of dengue patients in selected 74 hospitals was 529. In 22 hospitals, the average midnight total has increased and in 31 hospitals it has decreased compared to the previous week.

Selected hospitals with high average midnight totals of dengue patients and changing trend of dengue admissions in the  $6^{th}$  week are illustrated in Table 3.
