#### **DENGUE CASE REPORTING**

During the week 03, 1655 suspected dengue cases were reported in 25 districts in comparison to 2081 cases in 26 districts during the week 02. There is a 20.5% decrease in week 03, compared to the previous week. Of all cases 50.5% were reported from Western Province [Colombo Municipal Council - 7.3%, Rest of the Colombo District - 17.5%, Gampaha District - 18.4% and Kalutara District - 7.3%] (Table 1).

#### **HIGH RISK MOH AREAS**

Eighty-three MOH areas were flagged as high-risk areas during week 03. Out of them, 12 MOH areas showed rising number of cases in week 03 compared to the week 02, and another 42 MOH areas show persistently high number of cases in both weeks 02 and 03 (Table 2).


In week 03 high risk level of Hanwella, Bulathsinhala, Matugama, Poojapitiya, Baddegama, Elpitiya, Karandeniya, Tangalle, Walasmulla, Ibbagamuwa, MC Kurunegala, Mahawewa, Nattandiya, Madampe, Embilipitiya and Kegalle MOH areas have come down while Wadduwa, Udunuwara, Wattegama, Dambulla, Hikkaduwa, Kopay, Karaveddy, Kinniya, Kalmunai (South), Pottuvil, Maho, Pannala, Rasnayakapura and Mundel MOH areas were newly identified as high-risk areas.

#### **MIDNIGHT TOTAL OF DENGUE PATIENT ADMISSIONS**

Average midnight total of dengue patients in selected 69 hospitals throughout the country was 762\* and 596 during the weeks 02 and 03 respectively. In 13 hospitals, the average midnight total has increased in the week 03 when compared with the previous week (Table 3).

\*Average midnight total of the 02<sup>nd</sup> week shows an increase from 701 to 762 when compared to the previous week's report after updated with delayed reporting from hospitals.
