other than Paracetamol for Fever

- Dengue is reported in many parts of the country
- If you have fever there is a high chance that it may be due to dengue



Dengue Symptoms

- ★ Sudden onset of high fever
- ★ Headache
- ★ Pain behind the eyes
- ★ Body aches and pains
- ★ Nausea and vomiting
- ★ Skin rash and bleeding



NSAIDs

Mefenemic acid, Ibuprofen, Diclofenac

WHEN YOU HAVE FEVER ...

- For fever take 'Paracetamol' only
- Avoid taking drugs such as Mefenemic acid, Ibuprofen, Diclofenac belonging to NSAIDs group which can lead to **serious complications**
- NSAIDs in any form ; orally as tablets/ syrups, rectally or as injections should not be used

To prevent complications of DENGUE ...

- Don't take NSAIDs even on the 1st day of fever
- Don't take even a single dose of NSAIDs while taking Paracetamol
- Don't take NSAIDs even when you have high fever
- Don't take NSAIDs even if you are allergic to Paracetamol
- Don't use NSAIDs to prevent febrile convulsions in children
