### **DENGUE CASE REPORTING**

During the week 45, 933 suspected dengue cases were reported in 23 districts in comparison to 826 cases in 20 districts during the week 44. There is a 13% increase in the week 45, compared to the previous week (Table 1).

### **HIGH RISK MOH AREAS**

Forty-four MOH areas were flagged as high-risk areas during the week 45. Out of them, 17 MOH areas showed rising number of cases in the week 45 compared to the week 44, and 22 MOH areas show persistently high number of cases in both weeks 44 and 45 (Table 2).

In week 45 Minuwangoda, Meerigama, Horana, Harispattuwa (Werellagama), Maho, Hali Ela, MC Galle, MC Matara and Mutur MOH areas were newly identified as high-risk areas.

### MIDNIGHT TOTAL OF DENGUE PATIENT ADMISSIONS

Average midnight total of dengue patients in selected 69 hospitals throughout the country was 357\* and 333 during the week 44 and 45 respectively. In 21 hospitals, the average midnight total has increased in the week 44 when compared with the previous week.

DGH Negombo, National Hospital of Sri Lanka, Colombo South Teaching Hospital, National Institute of Infectious Diseases, PGH Badulla and Colombo North Teaching Hospital have reported the highest number of admissions (Table 3).

\*Average midnight total of the 44<sup>th</sup> week shows an increase from 329 to 357 when compared to the previous week's report due to delay in data reporting.
