

# WEEKLY DENGUE UPDATE

29th November 2021—05th December 2021 National Dengue Control Unit, Ministry of Health



### **DENGUE CASE REPORTING**

During the week 48, 1599 suspected dengue cases were reported in 25 districts in comparison to 1169 cases in 23 districts during the week 47. There is a 36.8% increase in the week 47, compared to the previous week (Table 1).

### **HIGH RISK MOH AREAS**

Fifty-three MOH areas were flagged as high-risk areas during the week 48. Out of them, 27 MOH areas showed rising number of cases in the week 48 compared to the week 47, and another 23 MOH areas show persistently high number of cases in both weeks 47 and 48 (Table 2).

In week 48 high risk level of Horana, Medadumbara, Bandarawela and Hali Ela MOH areas have come down while Divulapitiya, Dompe, Bandaragama, MC Kandy, Kalpitiya, Puttalam, Weligama, MC Jaffna, Mannar, PS Rathnapura, MC Rathnapura, Mawanella and Warakapola MOH areas were newly identified as high-risk areas.

### MIDNIGHT TOTAL OF DENGUE PATIENT ADMISSIONS

Average midnight total of dengue patients in selected 69 hospitals throughout the country was 525\* and 597 during the week 47 and 48 respectively. In 22 hospitals, the average midnight total has increased in the week 48 when compared with the previous week.

DGH Negombo, National Hospital of Sri Lanka, Colombo South Teaching Hospital, National Institute of Infectious Diseases, Colombo North Teaching Hospital, PGH Badulla, , and DGH Kalutara have reported the highest number of admissions (Table 3).

\*Average midnight total of the 47<sup>th</sup> week shows a decrease from 528 to 525 when compared to the previous week's report after updating with delayed reports.
