

WEEKLY DENGUE UPDATE

29th August 2022 – 04th September 2022 National Dengue Control Unit, Ministry of Health



DENGUE CASE REPORTING

During the week 35, 1254 suspected dengue cases were reported in 24 districts in comparison to 1304 cases in 23 districts during the week 34. There is a 3.8% decrease in week 35, compared to the previous week. Of all reported cases 50.1% were from Western Province [Colombo Municipal Council - 5.5%, Rest of the Colombo District - 12.0%, Gampaha District - 20.9% and Kalutara District - 11.6%]. Kandy [13.5%], Kegalle [6.9%], Galle [4.8%], and Rathnapura [4.0%] districts also have reported higher number of cases (Table 1).

HIGH RISK MOH AREAS

Thirty-four MOH areas were flagged as high-risk areas during week 35. Out of them, 10 MOH areas showed rising number of cases in week 35 compared to the week 34, and another 23 MOH areas show persistently high number of cases in both weeks 35 and 34 (Table 2).

In week 35 high risk level Dehiwala, Battaramulla, Egoda Uyana, MC Negombo, MC Matale, Walasmulla, Uduvil, Kalpitiya, Wennappuwa, MC Rathnapura, Dehiovita and Galigamuwa MOH areas have come down while Piliyandala, Moratuwa, Beruwala (NIHS), Horana, Kalutara (NIHS), Akuressa and Kegalle MOH areas were newly identified as high-risk areas.

MIDNIGHT TOTAL OF DENGUE PATIENT ADMISSIONS

Average midnight total of dengue patients in selected 73 hospitals throughout the country was 526 and 477 during the weeks 34 and 35 respectively. In 30 hospitals, the average midnight total has decreased in the week 35 when compared with the previous week (Table 3).
