DENGUE CASE REPORTING

During the week 40, 1152 suspected dengue cases were reported in 24 districts in comparison to 1161 cases in 22 districts during the week 39. There is a 0.8% decrease in week 40, compared to the previous week. Of all reported cases 47.6% were from Western Province [Colombo Municipal Council – 4.6%, Rest of the Colombo District – 14.1%, Gampaha District – 24.0% and Kalutara District – 4.8%]. Kandy [10.5%], Puttalam [6.9%], Galle [4.6%], and Jaffna [4.3%] districts also have reported higher number of cases (Table 1).

HIGH RISK MOH AREAS

Thirty-six MOH areas were flagged as high-risk areas during week 40. Out of them, 09 MOH areas showed rising number of cases in week 40 compared to the week 39, and another 21 MOH areas show persistently high number of cases in both weeks 40 and 39 (Table 2).

In week 40 high risk levels of Dehiwala, Moratuwa, Rathmalana, Ragama, Akkaraipattu, Kegalle, Kuruwita and MC Rathnapura MOH areas have come down while Kahathuduwa, Mirigama, Harispattuwa, Akmeemana, and Addalaichchenai MOH areas were newly identified as high-risk areas.

MIDNIGHT TOTAL OF DENGUE PATIENT ADMISSIONS

Average midnight total of dengue patients in selected 73 hospitals throughout the country was 431 and 463 during the weeks 39 and 40 respectively. In 19 hospitals, the average midnight total has decreased in the week 40 when compared with the previous week (Table 3).

*Average midnight total of the 39th week shows an increase from 428 to 431 when compared to the previous week's report after updated with delayed reporting from hospitals.
