

WEEKLY DENGUE UPDATE

21st February 2022—27th February 2022 National Dengue Control Unit, Ministry of Health



DENGUE CASE REPORTING

During the week 08, 748 suspected dengue cases were reported in 24 districts in comparison to 749 cases in 25 districts during the week 07. There is a 0.1% decrease in week 08, compared to the previous week. Of all cases 44.3% were reported from Western Province [Colombo Municipal Council – 4.1%, Rest of the Colombo District – 17.4%, Gampaha District – 13.8% and Kalutara District – 9.0%] (Table 1).

HIGH RISK MOH AREAS

Fifty MOH areas were flagged as high-risk areas during week 08. Out of them, 17 MOH areas showed rising number of cases in week 08 compared to the week 07, and another 15 MOH areas show persistently high number of cases in both weeks 07 and 08 (Table 2).

In week 08 high risk level of Kolonnawa, Nugegoda, Kahathuduwa, Katana, Minuwangoda, Seeduwa, Bandaragama, Wadduwa, Harispattuwa, MC Kandy, Balapitiya, Mannar, Kinniya, Kalmunai North, Pottuvil, Kurunegala, Nikaweratiya, Polgahawela, Wariyapola, Badulla, Eheliyagoda, Galigamuwa, Kegalle, Mawanella and Rambukkana areas have come down while Boralesgamuwa, Attanagalla, Divulapitiya, Mirigama, Ambalangoda, Kopay, Tellippalai, Nallur, Uduvil and Mundel MOH areas were newly identified as high-risk areas.

MIDNIGHT TOTAL OF DENGUE PATIENT ADMISSIONS

Average midnight total of dengue patients in selected 69 hospitals throughout the country was 215* and 251 during the weeks 07 and 08 respectively. In 52 hospitals, the average midnight total has increased in the week 07 when compared with the previous week (Table 3).

*Average midnight total of the 07th week shows a decrease from 240 to 215 when compared to the previous week's report after updated with delayed reporting from hospitals.
