DENGUE CASE REPORTING

During 28th week, 1091 suspected dengue cases were reported in 23 districts in comparison to 1061 in 24 districts during the 27th week. There is 2.8% increase in 28th week, compared to the previous week. Of all reported cases, 45.0% were from Western Province [Colombo Municipal Council - 5.5%, rest of the Colombo District - 17.5%, Gampaha District - 15.5% and Kalutara District - 6.5%]. Kandy [13.5%], Rathnapura [8.0%], Galle [5.0%], Kurunegala [4.9%], and Kegalle [3.6%] districts also have reported higher proportions of cases (Table 1).

HIGH RISK MOH AREAS (Table 2)

During 28th week, 27 MOH areas were flagged as high-risk. 17 MOH areas showed rising number than their respective numbers in previous week. Persistently high number of patients are observed in 9 MOH areas in both 27th and 28th week of 2025.

Werellagama, Mawanella, Rathnapura MC, Ambalangoda, CMC- D3, Battaramulla, Hanwella, Nugegoda, Gampaha, and Bandaragama newly flagged as high-risk MOH areas in the 28th week. Monaragala, MC Galle, Kurunegala, Kundasale, Kuruvita, Pelmadulla, Katana, Moratuwa, Dehiwala, and Piliyandala MOH areas flagged as high-risk in the 27th week, were not flagged in the current week.

MIDNIGHT TOTAL OF DENGUE PATIENT ADMISSIONS

* After updated with delayed reporting from hospitals, average midnight total for the 27th week shows an increase from 416 to 442.

In the 28th week average midnight total of dengue patients in selected 74 hospitals was 433. In 21 hospitals, the average midnight total has increased and in 25 hospitals it has decreased compared to the previous week.

Selected hospitals with high average midnight totals of dengue patients and changing trend of dengue admissions in the 28th week are illustrated in Table 3.
