DENGUE CASE REPORTING

During 12^{th} week, 828 suspected dengue cases were reported in 25 districts in comparison to 807 in 25 districts during the 11^{th} week. There is 2.6% increase in 12^{th} week, compared to the previous week. Of all reported cases, 50.0% were from Western Province [Colombo Municipal Council – 9.4%, rest of the Colombo District – 22.2%, Gampaha District – 13.6% and Kalutara District – 4.7%]. Rathnapura [9.1%], Kandy [7.4%], Galle [4.1%], Matara [4.1%], Batticaloa [3.5%], and Matale [3.5%] districts also have reported higher number of cases (Table 1).

HIGH RISK MOH AREAS (Table 2)

During 12th week, 20 MOH areas were flagged as high-risk; 11 MOH areas showed rising number than their respective numbers in previous week. Persistently high number of patients are observed in 13 MOH areas in both 11^{th} and 12^{th} week of 2025.

CMC-D4, CMC-D5, Boralesgamuwa, Nugegoda, Pitakotte, Rathmalana, Pugoda, Panadura, and Balangoda newly flagged as high-risk MOH areas in the 12th week. Moratuwa, Wattala and Mahara MOH areas flagged as high-risk in the 11th week, were not flagged in the current week.

MIDNIGHT TOTAL OF DENGUE PATIENT ADMISSIONS

* After updated with delayed reporting from hospitals, average midnight total for the 11th week shows an increase from 274 to 293.

In the 12th week average midnight total of dengue patients in selected 74 hospitals was 223. In 12 hospitals, the average midnight total has increased and in 24 hospitals it has decreased compared to the previous week.

Selected hospitals with high average midnight totals of dengue patients and changing trend of dengue admissions in the $12^{\rm th}$ week are illustrated in Table 3.


