#### **Indications to call for immediate advice**


1. Pulse rate > 120/min with fever or >100/min without fever.
  2. Pulse Pressure 25-20 mmHg or less (in supine position)
  3. Postural drop of SBP >20mmHg.
  4. Significant bleeding ( Haematemesis, Malena, Bleeding PV etc.)
  5. UOP <0.5ml /Kg/hr
  6. CRFT > 2 sec

**Monitor hourly and if in shock monitor more frequently until the patient is stable**


**Do HCT 3 hourly or more frequently**
