DENGUE CASE REPORTING

During the e-Week 43, 759 suspected dengue cases were reported in 23 districts in comparison to 828 cases in 20 districts during e-Week 42. The number of cases reported in e-Week 43 has been reduced by 69, compared to the previous week. However, in Jaffna, Mullativu and Trincomalee districts cases were reported in contrast to no case reporting during e Week 42 in these three districts (Table 1).

HIGH RISK MOH AREAS


Thirty-nine MOH areas were flagged as high-risk areas during e-Week 43. Out of them, 06 MOH areas showed rising number of cases in e -Week 43 compared to e-Week 42, and 33 MOH areas show persistently high number of cases in both e- Weeks 42 and 43. (Table 2)

MIDNIGHT TOTAL OF DENGUE PATIENT ADMISSIONS

Average midnight total of dengue patients in selected 69 hospitals throughout the country was 301 and 323 during e-Week 42 and 43 respectively. In 16 hospitals, the average mid night total has been increased in e-Week 43 when compared with the previous week.

National Hospital of Sri Lanka, DGH Negombo, Colombo South Teaching Hospital, Colombo North Teaching Hospital and PGH Badulla have reported the highest number of admissions.
