DENGUE CASE REPORTING

During the week 26, 3263 suspected dengue cases were reported in 26 districts in comparison to 2863 cases in 26 districts during the week 25. There is a 14.0% increase in week 26, compared to the previous week. Of all reported cases 56.8% were from Western Province [Colombo Municipal Council – 7.1%, Rest of the Colombo District – 23.7%, Gampaha District – 15.8% and Kalutara District – 10.2%]. Kandy [10.2%], Galle [4.9%], Kegalle [4.7%], and Rathnapura [4.7%] districts also have reported higher number of cases (Table 1).

HIGH RISK MOH AREAS

Seventy five MOH areas were flagged as high-risk areas during week 26. Out of them, 17 MOH areas showed rising number of cases in week 26 compared to the week 25, and another 58 MOH areas show persistently high number of cases in both weeks 25 and 26 (Table 2).


In week 26 high risk level of Padukka, Kesbewa, Matale, Rattota, Ambalangoda, Baddegama, Bope Poddala, Weligama, Tangalle, Tissamaharamaya, MC Jaffna, Karaveddy, Kalmunai North, Uppuveli, Eheliyagoda, and Pelmadulla MOH areas have come down while Mirigama, Mathugama, Gampola, Yakkalamulla, Welimada, Embilipitiya, Pelmadulla, Elapatha, Galigamuwa and Warakapola MOH areas were newly identified as high-risk areas.

MIDNIGHT TOTAL OF DENGUE PATIENT ADMISSIONS

Average midnight total of dengue patients in selected 69 hospitals throughout the country was 1112* and 1165 during the weeks 25 and 26 respectively. In 23 hospitals, the average midnight total has decreased in the week 26 when compared with the previous week (Table 3).

*Average midnight total of the 25th week shows an increase from 1106 to 1112 when compared to the previous week's report after updated with delayed reporting from hospitals.
