

# **WEEKLY DENGUE UPDATE**

## **DENGUE CASE REPORTING**

During the week 49, 1902 suspected dengue cases were reported in 26 districts in comparison to 1602 cases in 25 districts during the week 48. There is an 18.7% increase in week 49, compared to the previous week. Of all reported cases 43.0% were from Western Province [Colombo Municipal Council – 5.0%, Rest of the Colombo District – 12.2%, Gampaha District – 21.5% and Kalutara District – 4.3%]. Puttalam [15.3%], Kalmunai [8.4%], Jaffna [7.8%] and Kandy [4.5%] districts also have reported higher number of cases (Table 1).

#### **HIGH RISK MOH AREAS**

Fifty-five MOH areas were flagged as high-risk areas during week 49. Out of them, 28 MOH areas showed rising number of cases in week 49 compared to the week 48, and another 27 MOH areas show persistently high number of cases in both weeks 49 and 48 (Table 2).


In week 49 high risk levels of Kaduwela, Attanagalla, Dompe, Harispattuwa, Yatinuwara, MC Matale and Mannar MOH areas have come down while Dehiwala, Homagama, Pitakotte, Nugegoda, Hanwella, Rathmalana, Mirigama, Kundasale, Waththegama, Akuressa, Point Pedro, Nallur, Chenkalady, Anamaduwa, Dankotuwa, Mundel, Kuruwita and Sammanturai MOH areas were newly identified as high-risk areas.

### MIDNIGHT TOTAL OF DENGUE PATIENT ADMISSIONS

Average midnight total of dengue patients in selected 73 hospitals throughout the country was 583 and 646 during the weeks 48 and 49 respectively. In 25 hospitals, the average midnight total has decreased and in 28 hospitals the average mid night total has increased in the week 49 when compared with the previous week. Selected hospitals with high average midnight totals of dengue patients and changing trend of admissions in the week 49 are displayed in Table 3.

\*Average midnight total of the 48<sup>th</sup> week shows a decrease from 586 to 583 when compared to the previous week's report after updated with delayed reporting from hospitals.
