

WEEKLY DENGUE UPDATE

DENGUE CASE REPORTING

During the week 01 in 2022, 2057 suspected dengue cases were reported in 25 districts in comparison to 2026 cases in 25 districts during the week 52 in 2021. There is an 1.5% increase in the week 01, compared to the previous week. Of all cases 58.3% were reported from Western Province [Colombo Municipal Council – 5.7%, Rest of the Colombo District – 21.7%, Gampaha District – 22.2% and Kalutara District – 8.7%] (Table 1).

HIGH RISK MOH AREAS

Ninety MOH areas were flagged as high-risk areas during the week 01 in 2022. Out of them, 27 MOH areas showed rising number of cases in the week 01 in 2022 compared to the week 52 in 2021, and another 51 MOH areas show persistently high number of cases in both weeks 52 in 2021 and 01 in 2022 (Table 2).

In week 01 in 2022 high risk level of Dodangoda, Poojapitiya, Tangalle, Gangawatakorale, Kamburupitiva, Chavakachcheri, Kopay, MC Jaffna, Nallur, Sandilipay, Karaveddy, Maho, Polgahawela, Dankotuwa, PS Rathnapura and Kegalle MOH areas have come down while Padukka, Harispattuwa, Wattegama, Akmeemana, Baddegama, Bope, Elpitiya, Morawaka, MC Matara, Kinniya, Batticaloa, Valachcheni, Pottuvil, Udubaddawa, MC Kurunegala, Mahawewa, Nattandiya, Haputale, Balangoda, Embilipitiya, Dehiowita and Ruwanwella MOH areas were newly identified as high-risk areas.

MIDNIGHT TOTAL OF DENGUE PATIENT ADMISSIONS

Average midnight total of dengue patients in selected 69 hospitals throughout the country was 815* and 681 during the week 52 in 2021 and 01 in 2022 respectively. In 13 hospitals, the average midnight total has increased in the week 01 when compared with the previous week (Table 3).

*Average midnight total of the 52nd week in 2021 shows an increase from 795 to 815 when compared to the previous week's report after updating with delayed reports
