

# **WEEKLY DENGUE UPDATE**

#### **DENGUE CASE REPORTING**

During the week 07, 749 suspected dengue cases were reported in 25 districts in comparison to 634 cases in 24 districts during the week 06. There is a 18.1% increase in week 07, compared to the previous week. Of all cases 42.7% were reported from Western Province [Colombo Municipal Council – 5.2%, Rest of the Colombo District – 13.8%, Gampaha District – 15.6% and Kalutara District – 8.1%] (Table 1).

## **HIGH RISK MOH AREAS**

Sixty-seven MOH areas were flagged as high-risk areas during week 07. Out of them, 23 MOH areas showed rising number of cases in week 07 compared to the week 06, and another 16 MOH areas show persistently high number of cases in both weeks 06 and 07 (Table 2).


In week 07 high risk level of Pitakotte, Kesbewa, Attanagalla, Yatinuwara, Ambalangoda, Chavakachcheri, Point Pedro, Nallur, Mawathagama, Elapatha and MC Rathnapura MOH areas have come down while Hanwella, Kahathuduwa, Katana, Dompe, Minuwangoda, Seeduwa, Horana, Harispattuwa, Sandilipay, Kinniya, Kalmunai (North TD), Polgahawela, Wariyapola, Mahawewa, Galigamuwa, Kegalle, Mawanella and Rambukkana MOH areas were newly identified as high-risk areas.

### MIDNIGHT TOTAL OF DENGUE PATIENT ADMISSIONS

Average midnight total of dengue patients in selected 69 hospitals throughout the country was 251\* and 240 during the weeks 06 and 07 respectively. In 12 hospitals, the average midnight total has increased in the week 07 when compared with the previous week (Table 3).

\*Average midnight total of the 06<sup>th</sup> week shows a decrease from 255 to 251 when compared to the previous week's report after updated with delayed reporting from hospitals.
