DENGUE CASE REPORTING

During the week 13, 788 suspected dengue cases were reported in 25 districts in comparison to 798 cases in 25 districts during the week 12. There is an 1.3% decrease in week 13, compared to the previous week. Of all cases 34.8% were reported from Western Province [Colombo Municipal Council – 3.7%, Rest of the Colombo District – 11.8%, Gampaha District – 8.5% and Kalutara District – 10.8%] while 12.1% were from Galle District (Table 1).

HIGH RISK MOH AREAS

Fifty one MOH areas were flagged as high-risk areas during week 13. Out of them, 13 MOH areas showed rising number of cases in week 13 compared to the week 12, and another 11 MOH areas show persistently high number of cases in both weeks 12 and 13 (Table 2).

In week 13 high risk level of Dehiwala, Kaduwela, Moratuwa, Hanwella, Attanagalla, MC Negombo, Minuwangoda, Ragama, Wattala, Seeduwa, MC Kandy, Balapitiya, Point Pedro, Trincomalee (Naval base), Koralai Pattu Central, Eheliyagoda, Pelmadulla, Elapatha, and Badulla MOH areas have come down while Kahathuduwa, Katana, Wadduwa, Poojapitiya, Dambulla, Ambalangoda, Weligama, Kopay, Eravur, Akkaraipattu, Kalmunai North, Kuruwita, PS Rathnapura and Kegalle MOH Areas were newly identified as high-risk areas.

MIDNIGHT TOTAL OF DENGUE PATIENT ADMISSIONS

Average midnight total of dengue patients in selected 69 hospitals throughout the country was 250* and 263 during the weeks 12 and 13 respectively. In 19 hospitals, the average midnight total has decreased in the week 13 when compared with the previous week (Table 3).

*Average midnight total of the 12th week shows an increase from 235 to 250 when compared to the previous week's report after updated with delayed reporting from hospitals.
