

# WEEKLY DENGUE UPDATE

### **DENGUE CASE REPORTING**

During the week 14, 958 suspected dengue cases were reported in 24 districts in comparison to 788 cases in 25 districts during the week 13. There is an 21.6% increase in week 14, compared to the previous week. Of all cases 38.4% were reported from Western Province [Colombo Municipal Council – 4.3%, Rest of the Colombo District – 13.6%, Gampaha District – 9.9% and Kalutara District – 10.6%]. Jaffna [12.2%], Ratnapura [8.4%] and Galle [7.2%] districts also has reported higher number of cases (Table 1).

#### **HIGH RISK MOH AREAS**

Fifty two MOH areas were flagged as high-risk areas during week 14. Out of them, 18 MOH areas showed rising number of cases in week 14 compared to the week 13, and another 22 MOH areas show persistently high number of cases in both weeks 13 and 14 (Table 2).

In week 14 high risk level of Piliyandala, Katana, Mirigama, Horana, Poojapitiya, Dambulla, Ambalangoda, Baddegama, Habaraduwa, Weligama, Kalpitiya, Mc Rathnapura, Kegalle and Kalmunai North MOH areas have come down while Dehiwala, Nugegoda, Attanagalla, Ja-Ela, MC Negombo, Seeduwa, Tangalle, Chavakachcheri, Tellippalai, Velanai, Chenkalady, Seruwila, Uppuveli, Eheliyagoda and Embilipitiya, MOH Areas were newly identified as high-risk areas.

#### MIDNIGHT TOTAL OF DENGUE PATIENT ADMISSIONS

Average midnight total of dengue patients in selected 69 hospitals throughout the country was 276\* and 302 during the weeks 13 and 14 respectively. In 20 hospitals, the average midnight total has decreased in the week 14 when compared with the previous week (Table 3).

\*Average midnight total of the 13<sup>th</sup> week shows an increase from 263 to 276 when compared to the previous week's report after updated with delayed reporting from hospitals.
