DENGUE CASE REPORTING

During the week 17, 1896 suspected dengue cases were reported in 26 districts in comparison to 1909 cases in 26 districts during the week 16. There is a 0.7% decrease in week 17, compared to the previous week. Of all reported cases 49.0% were from Western Province [Colombo Municipal Council – 3.4%, Rest of the Colombo District – 17.9%, Gampaha District – 20.8% and Kalutara District – 6.9%]. Trincomalee [8.2%], Batticaloa [7.4%], Kandy [5.7%], Galle [3.5%] and Kegalle [3.3%] districts also have reported higher number of cases (Table 1).

HIGH RISK MOH AREAS

Fifty-four MOH areas were flagged as high-risk areas during week 17. Out of them, 17 MOH areas showed a rising number of cases in week 16 compared to the week 15, and another 37 MOH areas showed persistently high number of cases in both weeks 17 and 16 (Table 2).

In week 17, high risk levels of Kolonnawa, Pitakotte, Minuwangoda, Mirigama, Kalutara (NIHS), Galewela, Hambantota, Akmeemana, Akuressa, Karaveddy, Dehiovita and Kegalle MOH areas have come down Hanwella. Udunuwara, Wattegama, MC Galle, Walasmulla, Uduvil, Chenkalady, Eravur, Oddamavadai, Badulla and Kalmunai South MOH areas were newly identified as high-risk areas.

MIDNIGHT TOTAL OF DENGUE PATIENT ADMISSIONS

Average midnight total of dengue patients in selected 73 hospitals throughout the country was 693 and 675 during the weeks 16 and 17 respectively. In 27 hospitals, the average midnight total has decreased and in 26 hospitals the average mid night total has increased in the week 17 when compared with the previous week. Selected hospitals with high average midnight totals of dengue patients and changing trend of dengue admissions in the week 17 are displayed in Table 3.

*Average midnight total of the 16th week shows an increase from 684 to 693 when compared to the previous week's report after updated with delayed reporting from hospitals.
