## **DENGUE CASE REPORTING**

During the week 24, 2477 suspected dengue cases were reported in 26 districts in comparison to 2730 cases in 26 districts during the week 23. There is a 9.3% decrease in week 24, compared to the previous week. Of all reported cases 49.6% were from Western Province [Colombo Municipal Council -4.1%, Rest of the Colombo District – 17.8%, Gampaha District -20.9% and Kalutara District –6.7%]. Kandy [9.6%], Rathnapura [5.6%], Kegalle [5.9%], Batticaloa [3.8%], Kurunegala [3.6%] and Galle [3.2%] districts also have reported higher number of cases (Table 1).

### **HIGH RISK MOH AREAS**

Sixty-eight MOH areas were flagged as high-risk areas during week 24. Out of them, 10 MOH areas showed a rising number of cases in week 24 compared to the week 23, and another 58 MOH areas showed persistently high number of cases in both weeks 24 and 23 (Table 2).

In week 24, high risk levels of Pita Kotte, Padukka, Bandaragama, Kalutara (NIHS), Kurunduwatta, Chenkalady, Trincomalee, Ibbagamuwa, Kuliyapitiya, MC Kurunegala, Kuruwita and Rambukkana MOH areas have come down. Divulapitiya, Menikhinna, Hikkaduwa, MC Galle, Sooriyawewa, Okewela, Akuressa, Vavunatheevu, Oddamavadi, MC Ratnapura, Dehiovita, Ruwanwella, Warakapola, Yatiyantota and Bulathkohupitiya MOH areas were newly identified as highrisk areas.

### MIDNIGHT TOTAL OF DENGUE PATIENT ADMISSIONS

Average midnight total of dengue patients in selected 73 hospitals throughout the country was 913 and 868 during the weeks 23 and 24 respectively. In 23 hospitals, the average midnight total has increased and in 33 hospitals the average mid night total has decreased in the week 24 when compared with the previous week. Selected hospitals with high average midnight totals of dengue patients and changing trend of dengue admissions in the week 24 are displayed in Table 3.

\*Average midnight total of the 23<sup>rd</sup> week shows a decrease from 915 to 913 when compared to the previous week's report after updated with delayed reporting from hospitals.
