## WEEKLY DENGUE UPDATE

Week 51 (18<sup>th</sup> – 24<sup>th</sup> December 2023) National Dengue Control Unit, Ministry of Health

### **DENGUE CASE REPORTING**

During  $51^{st}$  week, 3375 suspected dengue cases were reported in 26 districts in comparison to 2438, in 26 districts during the  $50^{th}$  week. There is 38.4% increase in  $51^{st}$  week, compared to the previous week. Of all reported cases, 32.4% were from Western Province [Colombo Municipal Council – 2.6%, rest of the Colombo District – 18.3 %, Gampaha District – 7.9% and Kalutara District – 3.6 %]. Jaffna [20.4%], Kandy [11.0%], Galle [4.7%], Badulla [4.1%], Kegalle [4.1%] and Kurunegala [4.0%] districts also have reported higher number of cases (Table 1).

### HIGH RISK MOH AREAS (Table 2)

During  $51^{st}$  week, 71 MOH areas were flagged as high-risk. Of them, 61 MOH areas showed rising numbers than their respective numbers in previous week. Persistently high number of patients are observed in 57 MOH areas in both  $50^{th}$  and  $51^{st}$  weeks.

The MOH areas that were newly flagged as high-risk areas in 51<sup>st</sup> week are Kolonnawa, Boralesgamuwa, Divulapitiya, Bandaragama, Panadura, Udunuwara, Kayts, Velanai, Mutur, Dankotuwa, Nattandiya, Kegalle, Rambukkana and Mawanella. The MOH areas that were flagged as high-risk in 50<sup>th</sup> week and not flagged for the current week are; Kalutara (NIHS), Wadduwa, Menikhinna, Chenkalady, Chilaw, Puttalam, Kuliyapitiya and Godakawela.

### MIDNIGHT TOTAL OF DENGUE PATIENT ADMISSIONS

# \* After updated with delayed reporting from hospitals, average midnight total for the 50<sup>h</sup> week shows an increase from 969 to 995.

In 51<sup>st</sup> week average midnight total of dengue patients in selected 73 hospitals was 983. In 27 hospitals, the average midnight total has increased and in 28 hospitals it has decreased compared to the previous week.

Selected hospitals with high average midnight totals of dengue patients and changing trend of dengue admissions in the  $51^{st}$  week are illustrated in Table 3.
