

## WEEKLY DENGUE UPDATE

Week 10 (3<sup>rd</sup> – 9<sup>th</sup> March 2025)

#### **DENGUE CASE REPORTING**

During  $10^{th}$  week, 941 suspected dengue cases were reported in 24 districts in comparison to 828 in 24 districts during the 9<sup>th</sup> week. There is 13.6% increase in 10<sup>th</sup> week, compared to the previous week. Of all reported cases, 52.2% were from Western Province [Colombo Municipal Council – 13.1%, rest of the Colombo District – 20.0%, Gampaha District – 14.6% and Kalutara District – 4.6%]. Batticaloa [6.2%], Rathnapura [5.6%], Kandy [5.7%], Galle [4.1%], Matale [3.8%] and Matara [3.5%] districts also have reported higher number of cases (Table 1).

#### HIGH RISK MOH AREAS (Table 2)

During 10<sup>th</sup> week, 16 MOH areas were flagged as high-risk; 15 MOH areas showed rising number than their respective numbers in previous week. Persistently high number of patients are observed in 10 MOH areas in both 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> week of 2025.

Rattota, Dehiwala, Kaduwela, Maharagama, Nugegoda, Kelaniya, Pugoda, and Wadduwa newly flagged as high-risk MOH areas in the 10<sup>th</sup> week. Eravur, Oddamavadi, Pitakotte, and Weligama MOH areas flagged as high-risk in the 9<sup>th</sup> week, were not flagged in the current week.

#### MIDNIGHT TOTAL OF DENGUE PATIENT ADMISSIONS

\* After updated with delayed reporting from hospitals, average midnight total for the 9<sup>th</sup> week shows an increase from 231 to 303.

In the 10<sup>th</sup> week average midnight total of dengue patients in selected 74 hospitals was 269. In 30 hospitals, the average midnight total has increased and in 18 hospitals it has decreased compared to the previous week.

Selected hospitals with high average midnight totals of dengue patients and changing trend of dengue admissions in the  $10^{\rm th}$  week are illustrated in Table 3.
