

## WEEKLY DENGUE UPDATE

Week 24 (9<sup>th</sup> – 15<sup>th</sup> June 2025)

#### **DENGUE CASE REPORTING**

During 24<sup>th</sup> week, 1345 suspected dengue cases were reported in 25 districts in comparison to 1320 in 25 districts during the 23<sup>rd</sup> week. There is 1.9% increase in 24<sup>th</sup> week, compared to the previous week. Of all reported cases, 42.8% were from Western Province [Colombo Municipal Council - 3.8%, rest of the Colombo District - 18.1%, Gampaha District - 16.1% and Kalutara District - 4.8%]. Kandy [11.4%], Rathnapura [10.3%], Jaffna [6.8%], Kurunegala [4.8%], Batticaloa [3.6%], and Kegalle [3.4%] districts also have reported higher proportions of cases (Table 1).

#### HIGH RISK MOH AREAS (Table 2)

During 24<sup>th</sup> week, 36 MOH areas were flagged as high-risk. 25 MOH areas showed rising number than their respective numbers in previous week. Persistently high number of patients are observed in 27 MOH areas in both 23<sup>rd</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup> week of 2025.

Gampola, Werellagama, Point Pedro, Chankanai Walikamam West, CMC-D3, Egodauyana, Karaveddy, Piliyandala, Ja-Ela, Katana, and Pugoda newly flagged as high-risk MOH areas in the 24<sup>th</sup> week. Badalkumbura, Udunuwara, Godakawela, Kalawana, Rathnapura PS, CMC-D1, CMC-D2B, Boralesgamuwa, Nugegoda, Gampaha, Minuwangoda, Ragama, and Mirigama MOH areas flagged as high-risk in the 23<sup>rd</sup> week, were not flagged in the current week.

#### MIDNIGHT TOTAL OF DENGUE PATIENT ADMISSIONS

\* After updated with delayed reporting from hospitals, average midnight total for the 23<sup>rd</sup> week showed no difference (497).

In the 24<sup>th</sup> week average midnight total of dengue patients in selected 74 hospitals was 506. In 25 hospitals, the average midnight total has increased and in 22 hospitals it has decreased compared to the previous week.

Selected hospitals with high average midnight totals of dengue patients and changing trend of dengue admissions in the 24<sup>th</sup> week are illustrated in Table 3.
