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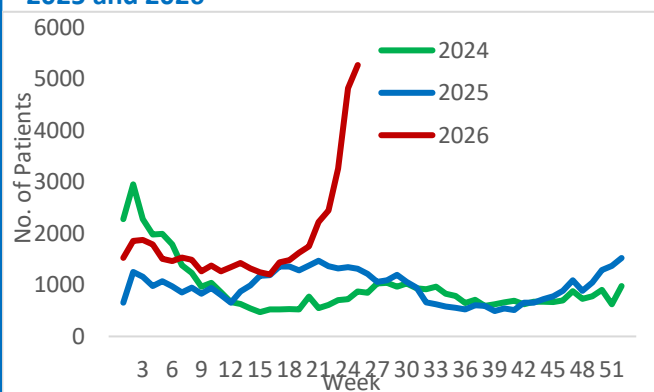

DENGUE CASE REPORTING

During the 25th week, 5267 suspected dengue cases were reported across 24 districts, compared to 4819 cases in the previous week, reflecting an **9.3% increase**. The Western Province accounted for 57.1% of total cases, with the Colombo Municipal Council (CMC) contributing 3.7%, the rest of Colombo District 20.9%, Gampaha District 23.9%, and Kalutara District 8.6%. Outside the Western Province, notable case contributions were reported from Kandy (8.4%), Matara (7.2%), Galle (4.7%), Hambantota (3.5%), Ratnapura (3%), Puttalam (2.5%), and Kegalle (2.5%) (see Table 1).

HIGH RISK MOH AREAS

As presented in Table 2, during the 25th week of 2026, 124 Medical Officer of Health (MOH) areas were identified as high-risk, including 25 newly flagged areas (highlighted in light red in Table 2). Previously classified 13 high-risk MOH areas in week 24, were not identified as high-risk in the 25th week of 2026 (Table 2).

MIDNIGHT TOTAL OF DENGUE PATIENT ADMISSIONS

** After incorporating delayed hospital reports, the average midnight total for the 24th week increased from 1590 to 1651.*

In the 25th week of 2026, the average midnight total of dengue patients across 74 sentinel hospitals was 2179. Compared to the previous week, in the 25th week, 53 hospitals reported an increase, while 5 reported a decrease.

Table 3 highlights sentinel hospitals with high average midnight totals and changes in dengue admissions during the 25th week.
